In the First place I recommend my Soul into The Hands of Almighty God who gave it and my body to be decently buried at The descretion of my Executors, and as for my worldly concerns. I Endow them in manner and form Following. Imprimis I give and bequeath unto my wife Jane Cockrel the chiefe Part of the Plantation I now live on begin(ing at Lavenders Corner and my corner. from Thence a Strait line to a pine corner upon Hugh Teagues line. thence with the North line round the said land to the beginning. also the third part of my moveable property. Negroes Excepted as they are not my property no longer than I live

Item I give and Bequeath unto my Son Jeremiah Cockrel that track of land which he now lives on and the negroes also which we have already contracted about the contract being such that I ve the use of the negroe for the use of- of the land while I live. also his part of my moveable property

Item I give and bequeath unto my Son Nathaniel Cockrel Two Hundred and fifty acres of land Join(ing Land He now lives on. and his part of the moveable property.

Item I give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Mary Moland all That parfel or Tract of Land Joining John Richmond and Sammel Armstrong which at the time of Gunning was va(cant land. also a share of the moveable property

Item I give and bequeach unto my Daughter Sarah Martin all the portion allriady. that I entend to give her

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Liah Neel Her Equal share of my moveable property

My end- Defere is that my two Sons Jeremiah Cockrill,

and Natha(neil Cockrel be the Executors of this my last Will and Testament. ratifying and confirming This to be my last will and all others hertefore made to be void and of none Effect. Also my will and Desire is that my freend Burr Harrison should act to settle all my acc^{ts} and Determine all all Desputes that may arise from this my last will in winners whereof I've
