One horse, Saddle and Bridle, the Horse the choice of any that is of my Property, One Iron pot, Two sppinning Wheels a large one, and a small one, One plow Fairfield County Will Bland 1787 1791 the Remainder of

Also I lend to her the use of my Plantation whereen I now dwell and the premises thereon during her Widowhood, and the remainder of the moveables if she sees cause to keep it together.
