ley an adopted Child twenty pounds In Money of he raise
and works along with the Rest till he Comes of age to be
paid out of the hole Estate

Moreover if my wife Elizebeth Richardson should Marries
again then her share to be as small as the Law would aforde
Moreover I Request and authorise my Executors Elizebeth
Richardson Robert Richardson and James Elliot to see that
the estate is not wasted by unnecessary mains Given under
