I Sarah Bonnet of Fairfield County, being very weak and low in Body, but of perfect Mind and Memory, thanks be given unto God; calling unto Mind the Mortality of my Body, and knowing that it is appointed for all persons to die, do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament: That is to say, principally, and first of all, I give and recommend my Soul into the Hand of Almighty God that gave it, and my Body I recommend to the Earth, to be buried in decent Christian Burial, ~~at the discretion~~ of my Executors. And as touching such worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to blefs me in this Life, I give, devise, and dispose of the Same in the following Manner and form- - - - -

It follows First I give and bequith unto my belove son William Kirkland all my Nigrows by name one Nigro Man Named Dundon, two Nigrows Women, Nan and Lucy: three Children, Jack, Jinney and Peter and Also All my Moveable property Horses Cattle Shoop and hogs and Household furniture
