I Thomas Routledg of Craven County and province aforesaid, being afflicted with sicknefs and low in Body, though of the ~~abundance of mercy and goodnefs of God in perfect Mind and~~ Memory, praised be God, do make this my last will and Testament and desire it may be received by all as such, Imprimis, I will that all my debts and Burial charges be paid and discharged by my Executor hereinafter named, Item, I Give and bequeath unto my two daughters Rachal and Sarah, whom I left in ~~pennsilvany~~ Government the Sum of Five pounds Currency of this province each, to be paid to them if ever demanded I do Give and bequeath unto Mathew Raiford the Son of Phillip Raiford ~~deced~~ That plantation & Tract of Land, which was left and willed to me by Phillip Raiford deceased I do Give unto my loving ~~wife~~ <sup>Fairfield County Will BK 1, 1787-1791</sup> Margaret Routledg <sup>www.southcarolinahistorical.com</sup> all my Goods and Chattels and real and personal Estate after payment of my debts charges and Legacies as afors.d Lastly I do make and Constitute my said wife Margaret Routledg Executrix and my true & Trusty Friend William Raiford Executor of this my last will and Testament IN WITNEFS whereof I have hereunto Set my hand and Seal this Twenty ninth day of October 1761
