and in the 18th year of American Independence make and pub-
lish this my last Will and Testament in manner and form

following First I commit my Soul into the hands of Almighty
God, who gave it and my body to be interred in the Earth in
a decent and Christian manner at the discretion of my ex-
ecutors nothing doubting but at the general resurrection,

I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God
and as for any worldly Estate that God hath intrusted me
with. I give and bequeath it in the following manner, First

I give and bequeath to my Mother Jane Phillips Twenty pounds
out of my personal property. 2. I give and bequeath to my

Nephew John Phillips Two hundred Acres of my plantation
whereon I now live, including the whole of the Improvements,

only with this proviso that he pay to his brother William

I give to my nephew Thomas Phillips a tract of land of Fifty
acres only he to pay to his sister Jane and Betty Phillips

to my nephew John Sloane Junior one Hundred Acres part of
the tract whereon I now live, to be laid off or adjoining
Thomas Clinneys land, an^d including pring there only

he to pay to my sister Elizabeths Children Ten pounds and
five pounds to my sister Mary Campbell, in seven years from

my decease, 5th I allow the remainder of my personal pro-
perty to be equally divided between my sisters Mary, Jane
and Elizabeth, except five pounds which I bequeath to my
nephew James Phillips and likewise what will pay my debts.

all the above payments out of my lands to be paid in proper-
ty at the reward of Two Freeholders and I do hereby author-
ise Constitute and appoint Edward M.

he to pay to my Sister Elizabeths Children Ten pounds and five pounds to my Sister Mary Campbell, in seven years from

my decease, 5th I allow the remainder of my personal property to be equally divided between my Sisters Mary, Jane

and Elizabeth, except Five pounds which I bequeath to my

nephew James Phillips and likewise what will pay my debts.

all the above payments out of my lands to be paid in property at the reward of Two Freeholders and I do hereby author-

ise Constitute and appoint Edward Martin and James Neely

Executors of this my will, instruct, for the Interest and purposes in this my will contain'd and to take care and see the same performed according to my true Intent and meaning IN WITNESS whereof I the said William Phillips have to this my last will and Testament set my hand and Seal the day and year above written.
