Therefore calling unto mind the Mortality of my Body and knowing that it is appointed for all men Once to die, make and Ordain this my last Will and Testament, That is to say principally and first of all I give and recommend my soul into the Hands of Almighty God, that you it, and my Body I recommend to the Earth to be buried in decent Christian Burial at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at the general Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God, and as touching such worldly Estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me in this Life Before demise and dispose of the same in the following manner and form, First I give and bequeath to Esperance Kirklin my Dearly beloved wife her choice of the two Cows and their Increase and one two year Old Heifer and one three year old Steer and one two year old Heifer and one year old Steer likewise her choice of one of my Horses likewise One Horse Named Turp and likewise one Son that goes by the name of Ginney Sow and all her shotes and Pigs and one Bay mare known by the name of the Swallow Mare, her and her Increase, and one feather =

Father Bed and Furniture which she likes best and the third part of the pewter likewise the third part of all my Household Goods and two Old side saddles and the wheels and Cards and the third part of my working Tools likewise I lend her the use of one Negroe Winch Named Scrubine during her Natural life, Also I give to my well beloved daughter Elisabeth Buffor one sow, also I give to my well beloved Grandson John Kirklin son of Joshua Kirklin my Son one shilling Sterling to be paid after my deceas & also I give to my well beloved daughter ^{the} Mrs. Hallston Forty Shillings Current Money of this Province to paid off in truck by my Executors, also I give to my well beloved Granddaughter Ginney Kirklin One yearling Heifer, also I lend to my daughter in law Esperance Joyce Seven head of cattle and Increase to her and her Heirs, also I give to my well beloved Son William Kirklin One Bay Horse Named Steigh and one black Mare and her yearling Colt and her Prawas, Also I give to my well beloved Son Richard Kirklin One Brown Grey Horse and One white Horse and all my stone that I have in the swamp Likewise for the same.
