In the name of Good Amen I James Forrister of Greenville

a bequeath to my loving wife Elizabeth my plantation whereon I now live and my household furniture & creatures & cattle & hogs & working tools during her life time then al the moovable estate to fail to my loving son hardy Forrister & the land and plantation to my loving son hichard Forrister

the land containing one hundred and Sixty nine acres. I give and bequeath to my loving son John Forrister my plantation on suck creek containing two hundred acres of land and I hereby make and ordain Joseph O Bannon and Hardy Forrister executors of this my last will and testament in witness

whereof I the said James Forrester have to this my last will and testament set my hand and the day and year above written. Signed scaled .ublished and declared by the said, James

Forrester the testator as his lust will and test-ment in the presence of us who are present at the time of signing and sealing thereof.
