In the name of God Amen I Joshua Hawkins of Greenville District and State of South Carolina being of sound mind & perfect emory do make & ordain this to be my last will & testament (viz)

Impremise I give & bequeath my soul to almighty God that first gave it me & my body to be decently buried at the discretion of my executors herein mentioned.

Item. I give & bequeath to my beloved wife Sarah Cook Hawkins my whole estate real & personal during her natural life.

Item. My will & desire is that at the death of my beloved wife that the whole of my movable est te be equally divided between my youngest son Linckney Hawkins & my grandson Isham Hawkins. Item I give & bequeath to my son Linckney Hawkins at the death of my beloved wife all my lands containing two hundred acres.

Item. Lastly I constitute & appoint my sons Eaton Hawkins & Linckney Hawkins executors of this my last will & testament hereby revoking & disannulling all former wills heretofore by me made in witness whereof I have herein set my hand & seal the 16th day of May 1801.
