WILLIAM HUNT

In the name of God Amen.

I William Hunt of Greenville ~~district and State of South Carolina~~  
being of perfect mind & memory do this twentieth day of January  
one thousand eight hundred & seven make & publish this my last  
will & testament in manner & form following that is to say first

I recommend my soul to God that first gave it me & my body to  
be buried at the descretion of my executors hereafter named &  
as for what worldly goods it hath pleased God to bless me with in  
this life I dispose of in manner following to wit.

Item. I give & bequeath unto my daughter Tabby all the profits  
arising from the sale of four negroes named Frank Vine, Frank  
son of Frank Suckey and Leethey which I formerly impowred Dyer  
Talley to sell also one bed & furniture which she has in poss-  
ession to her & her heirs for ever.

Item. I give & bequeath unto my son James one negro woman named  
Lucy one boy named Tom one named Henry and one girl named Amy,  
also all my part of a tract of land lying & being in Granville  
County in N. Carolina formerly given me by my uncle James Hunt also  
one featherbed & furniture to him and his heirs forever.

Item. I give & bequeath unto my daughter Salley one negro woman  
named Rachel one girl named Tiller one named Dilly & one boy named  
Isom which I have given her in possession also one bed & furniture  
to her and her heirs forever.

Item. I give and bequeath unto Thomas Tadsworth Elkin son of my  
daughter Polly one negro girl named Alse and one named Darcas and  
one boy named Anderson also one bed & which my said daughter Polly  
had in her possession at her death and if the said Thomas Tadsworth  
should die without lawful issue His part of my estate to be equally  
divided among the rest of my surviving children.

Item. I give and bequeath unto my daughter Nanny one negro woman  
named Selah one girl named Lottie one boy named Ephraim also Swiss

& one bed & furniture to her and her heirs forever.

Item. I give & bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth one negro boy named Sam one girl named Haley one boy John one featherbed & furniture and one saddle to her and heirs forever.

Item. I give & bequeath unto my daughter Rose one negro girl named Phillis one boy named Willie one named Summons one featherbed & furniture and one saddle to her and her heirs forever.

Item. I give and bequeath unto my son Davis one negro boy named George one fellow named Jack one woman named Jude one girl named Billy child of Jude also my land and plantation whereon I now live (only my wife to have the use of the land during her natural life) also one sorrel filly one featherbed and furniture to him and his heirs forever.

Item. I lend unto my beloved and lawful wife Mary all my land and plantation whereon I now live with all the plantations tools and household furniture and stock and corn and meat that is on the place after my just debts is paid out of my stock of corn or other moveable property as my executors may think can be spared best also I lend her during her natural life one negro man named Hall one Jim one girl named Chany after the death of my wife my will & desire that my land and plantation stock of hogs & one cubbord two walnut tables be my son Davis, the rest of my property to be sold and equally divided between all my living children but if my wife should decease soon after my decease or before my younger children become of age I wish my younger to be dealt with as nearly as may be equally with my elder children as to schooling and other small matters also my will & desire is that if any of my children dies without lawful issue that their part of my estate be equally divided amongst the rest of my surviving children and I do hereby appoint my friend Phil Bradford my son James Hunt and Dyer Tally executors of this my last will and testament hereby disannulling all other will heretofore by me made in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the day and year above written.
