After the payment of my debts, funeral expenses etc, my Excrs to make following divisions; I give to my wife Nancy T Moon, 200 &. 2 negroes

(Stephen Hariett), I black horsenamed Charley ,saddle, bridle I yoke steers & cart, 2 cows& callyes and hand of each of steers & pigs, all house hold and kitchen furniture, my crop of cotton all property in my smoke house crop of corn, flour fodder shucks etc sufficient amount to run her until another crop.

2nd- I give to my dau Nancy Ligon, negro menry, to her & her heirs forever

3rd after my decease my Excrs to sell negroes, Charley, Cleo, boy Andrew Lewis Ceily, remaining corn flour, fodder stock of horses, cattle, hogs sheep, 3 feather beds, bedsteads, furniture one set of china ware (except the part set aside for my wife of which she is to take her choice) The money arrivinf from said sale to be equally divided among my hears; Viz; Robert C. Moon, Cohn Moon, Fleasant Moon, the heirs of David T. Cureton(this appears to be a dau which is deceased)

He futher says at death of his wife, that negroe Stephen & Harriett and her increase be sold by Excrs and equally between my heirs, "obert D Moon(note was Robt C. in above) John Moon, Pleasant Moon, the heirs of D.T. Cureton, Folly "ilgore, Nancy Ligon
