I John Dill of South Carolina Greenville District Beinge old and frail in bodey But of a perfect mind and memery and callinge to mind the mortality of my body knowinge all men has onst to Dyi; do make this my Last will and testament Revokinge and Disnulinge all others by me made that is to Say first of all I Give and Rec-omend my Sole to God that Give it me and my bodey to the Earth to be Beareyd in Chrestal buarel at the decresion of my Executurs Nothings doutinge but at the General Reserection I shall Reseve the Same by the Mitey power of God, and as touchinge my Earthey Estate that God has ben pleased to Bless me With I Give and bequeath in the fowlowinge maner that is to Say first I Give to my Lovinge Grandaughtor Peggey Randolf one feather Bed and furnitue and one two years old heffer Secondly I give and bequeath unto My well beloved wife Mary ann Dill all the Ballers of My Estate at hur Disposhel while a widow or livinge and at her Death or Marrege to be Equally Divided Amonge all me Children and Lastly I do Ordain and apint my Lovinge Son Renuls Dill and George Mitch the Sole Executurs of this my Last will and testament as witnes my hand and Seal this 7th day of March 1807
