named Lively and all other property delivered to her. To son
Phillip C. Lester one negro man named Daniel and all other property
delivered to him. To son Hartwell Lester a man named Ned and all
other property delivered to him. A negro girl named Nancy and
present and future increase to be held in trust by my Executors
for the sole use and benefit of daughter Armon Green and at her
death, the girl Nancy and her increase is to be divided among the
lawfully begotten heirs of Armon Green. All other property, both
real and personal, is to be sold at public auction and the net
proceeds, after payment of just debts, is to be divided into seven
shares with one share going to each of the following children or
their heirs: Rebecca Cantelon, Phillip C. Lester, Hartwell
Lester, and Milly Sherley. Three shares are to be placed at
interest by my Executors and the interest from one share paid
yearly to daughter Alice Beacham during her life and at her death
to be equally divided among her children. The same for daughters
Polly Rutledge and Armon Green.
