ISAAC MORGAN

IN THE NAME OF GOD AMEN

I Isaac Morgan of Greenville County and State of South Carolina being sick and weak of body, but of sound mind and memory, therefore calling to mind the mortality of my body and knowing all must die, and touching my worldly goods with which it has pleased God to bless me in this life I do will and bequeath it in the following manner To wit Item I lend to my beloved wife Nancey Morgan one half of my Plantation and tract of land whereon I now live that is to say on the North side of Enoree river during her life, I give and bequeath to my said wife all my Negroes untill my son Jesse and daughter Jean come of age, and then that she my said wife retain one third part of said Negroes during her life also I will and bequeath to her one third part of all my stock of horses Hogs etc. with their Increase, and one fourth part of my Cattle and Also one third of all my household furniture And I will and Devise to my son Jesse the other Half of the Plantation whereon I now live that is to say on the North side of Enoree river to be freely possessed by him after my Decease and also one Equal third part of all my stock of horses hogs and household furniture and one fourth part of my stock of cattle 3rd I will and devise to my Daughter Jean all that part of my afforesaid tract of land lying on the south side of said Enoree river whereon John Cox now lives to be freely possessed by her and that Immediately after the term is Expired that the said John Cox has leased it for and also one Equal third part of my Horses Hogs and household furniture and one fourth part of my cattle 4th I will and bequeath to my wives Daughter Elizabeth Ellison one fourth part of my stock of cattle to be freely possessed by her as her own 5th I will and bequeath to my son Jesse after the Death of my wife all that part of my tract of land lent her during her life lying on the north side of Enoree river to him and his heirs and also I give and bequeath to my said son Jesse after the Death of my wife the one half of the whole of my Negroes with their increase to him and his heirs 6th I will and bequeath to my Daughter Jean after the death of my wife

the other half of my Negroes with their increas to her and her heirs. 7th my will and Desire is that my wife Nancey have the raising and the care of two children Jesse and Jean untill they come of age or day of marriage 7th my will and Desire is that the Debts that I owe be paid out of whole of my Estate to wit out of stock and crop before any Division be made of my afferesaid Estate. 8th I will and bequeath to my beloved wife Nancey my son Jesse and my Daughter Jean the whole of my plantation tools wagon etc. to be Equally Divided between them three, also that Each of the legatees have the increas of their part of the stock 9th My will and Desire is that if Either of my Children should die under age without Issue the Estate of Deceased shall devolve on the survivor Lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my beloved wife Nancey Morgan and my friend Robert McAfee Executors of this my last will and testament, and I do hereby Disalow revoke and Dis annul all former legacies and bequests heretofore by me made ratifying this and none other to be last will and testament in testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the 12th day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Ninety four
