5. I do give & Bequeath to Polly Gregory one suit of Home spun & one

suit of Store Cloathing, a Bed & furniture a Wheel & cards. 6, I do nominate & appoint my Sons Samuel & James Sole Executors of this my last will & Test. And do hereby utterly disallow revoke and disanull all other former Wills or Bequests whatsoever hereto-
