To my daughter Milley Hollan Betsey Snow and the deirs of my daughter Molley a e eceased, and Benjamin Tarrant, Junior, to each of bem five pounds starling having formly given them a part of my estate that is twenty pounds to be paid by my executors to them on or at the division of my state and the remaining part to be equally divided between my sons Leonard, "latt, Robert, Samuel, James and John Tarrant and lastly do nominate my beloved wife martha Tarrant and my sons Leonard and famuel Tarrant executors of this my last will and testament.
