ISAAC WICKLIFF

The following last will and testament of Isaac Wickliff dec<sup>d</sup> was presented in open court in October term 1797 and proven by the oath of Charles Allen an ordered to be recorded which was done this 10th day of December AD 1797.

In the name of God Amen I Isaac Wickeliff of Greenville County in the State of So Carolina being at present weakin boddy tho of sound mind & perfect senses doemak ordain this my last will & testament in manner following to wit Impremice I give and bequeath my sole to almighty God that first gave it me & my body to be decently buried at the discreession of my executors herein after mentioned. Item I give & bequeath my my whole estate real & personal to my beloved wife Franky Wickliff to dispose of as she may think proper. Item it is my will & desire that my will be proved of record out no further expenses to accrow thereon. Lastly I constitute & appoint my beloved wife Franky Wick iff executrix of this my last will & testament revoking & disannulling all former wills by me made in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 14th day July one thousand seven hundred & ninety seven.
