Item it is my will & desire that my will be prooved of record out no further expenses to accress thereon. Lastiy i constitute & appoint my beloved wife Franky lick iff executrix of this my last will & test-ment revoking & disannulling all former wills by me made in "itness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & scal this 14th day July one thousand seven hundred & ninety seven.
