I Michael Clardy under the Consideration of Death, Think it proper to make this my last will and Testament, Being in my wright Senses and wright minde; In the first place I wish all my Lawfull debts to be paid -

Secendly I wish all my Property to be kept Together untill my son Joseph come of age, Thirdly if he should dye the same untill William should come of age, Forthly If my wife should Marry the property must be equally divided and she have her equal share, And then the Property to be lumped Together and Continue as before mentioned, But her share at her death to return to my Children,

Her dower to be laid of for her on the Plantation residing on, during her life time, Fifthly I wish my sons to have all my Lands equally divided between them, And an Equal share besides the Land, Sixthly, If any of my Children should mary before the Divishien, I wish them assisted with a negre or two, such ones as is most proper, (considered as a lone,) untill the divishien, Seventh, If any of my Children should Mary and ^{die} leaving not an heir of there hody The property must return to there brothers

& sisters Eight, Respecting my Dear Afflicted Sister I can only leave her in the Hands of God, and the care Of my Adminstrators & Executors her Property can be Applied in any way which They think best Tenth, My Dear Wife, Keep her under our reughf and / your Protection as long as you Pesabley can Indure it, Your reward waits before your, Eleventh, My last request after leaving my Dear wife and little Childred; In the hands of my God, Praying his Protection and Assistance, I leave my Wife Mary Clardy Armilain Bryan & Thomas Blackwell, as Administrators & Executors to this my last Will and Testamen
