Edward Conner's Estate continued

Bern 17. 1844. Sent letters by mail to Edward Mansfield directed to Township Darlington District S.C. to Edward Conner at same Post office Wm Glisson at same post office Dennis Hawkins Anthony Lake, Florida George Heavens John Heavens & Edward Heavens Smithville A.C. Wm Gore & wife at Basses P.D. Columbia A.C. and advertisement sent to E Waterman same day also Wm Brewer at Millidgeville Ga.

March 15 1845 being the day on which the time expired by law for advertising for absent heirs Consent for sale of the lands having been made by Heavens Hawkins Ludlam Graham

It is decreed that the lands of the said Edward Conner lying lying on Hills Islands consisting of one tract of thirty three acres bound on N.E. by Grapette land on the S.W. by Conner's land and sold by George W. Grapette to Edward Conner 15 Aug 1819 and by him transferred to Edward Conner 14 March 1825

2^o One tract 400 acres granted to John Cox 2d June 1775 on S.W. Branch of Buck Creek Swamp and transferred from John Cox Mary Cox and Mercy Cox as heirs and legatees of John Cox to Edward Conner dated 12 Feb 1817

3 The right & title of Conner to 467 acres being part of 1000 acres granted to John Cox in 1792 as per survey made by Dennis Hawkins 2d day of Dec 1825.

On the following terms so much as will be necessary to pay expenses of Partition to be paid in cash and the balance payable in part of lot next purchased to give bond and approve security bearing interest from the day of sale with Mortgage of the premises.
