JOHN FOLEY

In the Name of God Amen I John Foley being thru the abundant  
 mercy and goodness of god the wick in body yet of a sound and  
 perfect understanding and memory do constitute this my last  
 will and testament and Desier it may be receivd by all as such  
 first I mos humbly bequath my soul To god my maker beseeching his  
 most gracious acceptance of it through the all sufficient merits  
 and mediation of my most Compationate redemer Jesus Christ who  
 gave him self to be an atonement for my sins and is abel to  
 save to the uttermost all that Come unto god by him seeing he  
 ever livith to mak intercession for them and tve I trust will not  
 reject me are turning penitent sinner when I Come to him for  
 mercy in this hope and Confidence I render up my soul with  
 Comfort humbly beseeching the most blessed and glorious trinity  
 one god <sup>most</sup> holy most mercifull and gracious to prepare me for the  
 time of my Dissolution and then to take me to him self into  
 that peace and rest and incomparabel felicity which he has  
 prepared for all that love and fear his holy name amen blessed  
 be god I give my body to the the earth from whence it was  
 taken in full asurance of its resorrection from thence at the  
 last Day as for my burial I Desier it may be Desent without  
 pomp or state at the Discretion of my Dear wife and my Executors  
 hear after named who I doubt not <sup>will</sup> manage it with all requisit  
 prudents as to my worldly estate I will and positive order that  
 all my Debts be paid: and - first I give to my Dear and loving  
 wife this plantation and hous wheare in I now live and all my  
 Cattel and all my hogs and my negro wench Cate and all my hous  
 held furneture and all my plantation tools Dure <sup>ing</sup> / hir life: and  
 three-hin I give to my Daughter Clee three hundred and thrty  
 six acres of land on shubucket branch and after hir Decens to  
 hir Daughter betsey and to my grandauter salley crowson one half  
 fer: and to betsey asteam: and to my Daughter selah all my  
 land below bees branch on the west side of the farnsprings and  
 after hir decens to hir son James and I give to my Daughter <sup>of land</sup> betsey  
 two hundred acres / on both sides of the lorn spring above  
 the plantation wheare I live and after hir Decens to hir son

stepen (and two hundred acres of land on ~~both~~ creek to my daughter betsey and also three hundred acres of land on both sides of hadecks land) and I give to my Daughter Salla all my land on the west sid of the iern springs above bebs branch as fur as that other to hund acres guen to betses at my wifes Deceas: and I give to my Daughter nancey all my land on the Est side of the iern springs as Lg as that other two hundre acres of land given to betse and also I give to my Dughter nancey seventy five acres of land on mitchets swamp at murrels old feeld: and I give to my Daughters betse and salla that small bunch of cattel at my brothers to be equelly Divided between them and after my wife Deceas for nancey to have my Negro wench Oate and after two Cows and Calves to Clee / and 2 two Cow and calves to my grand Daughter nancey Williamsen and after my wifes Decease for my stock and household good plantation tols and al my other affears to bee Equelly Divided between betse salla and nancey and I Do Constitute my wife and W. Norton Executors of this my last will and testament in this in witness wheare of I have heare unto set my hand and seal the 17 Day of Nov 1800
