During her Life and at her Decease I doe allow the same to return unto my beleved son stevin Forwerth and his heirs forever I allso give unto my beloved wife Mary Foxworth one Negroe man named anthony & his wife Judy & another wench Named Jermy & another young Megroe Man named tony & another young boy named Cain another boy Dick and one girl named Judy another named Mariah another girl named Jin another Named yanges another boy named Mare another girl named Lydia allse I give unto my beloved wife one Sorrell mare & one brown bay mare & one two year old sorrell herse allso all my stock of Cattle & sheep belonging to my home plantation alise all my stock of hogs accept ten breeding sows, alls I give Unto My beloved wife mary Perworth " all my housheld furniture accept two feather beds, & furniture Item I - I give Unto my beloved son Stephen Fexworth all my other Lands, that I am posfesed with and all the Cattle in his own Mark allso all my other stock of Cattle Recept the home stock I give Unto my son Stephen Poxworth one Megroe wench named hannah & one boy Mamed allick one ather negroe bey named Jeffry to him a heirs forever I give unto my son steven-Forworth one negree boy and gas Dick and one negroe girl Mamed yanaca and one boy named Mare allready given to my beleved wife Mary Formorth but he not to here said negroes till her Death than to his a his heirs forever des all other of the Megroes all other of the hemshould furniture all the stock of Cattle skeep
