 ner at the Discrefion of my Exeputers here after mentioned and
 as for such worldly goods. as it hath pleased god to blefs me
 with I will And bequeath. Item I give unto my beloved wife
 Mary Foxworth My plantation ~~Wh~~ my house now - Stand that
 is to say one track of Land Containing six hundred and Sixty
 acers and all the appurtinances belong thereunto - During her
 Life and at her Decease I doe allow the same to return unto
 my beloved son stevin Foxworth and his heirs forever I allse
 give unto my beloved wife Mary Foxworth one Negree man named
 antheny & his wife Judy & another wench Named Jenny & another
 young Negree Man named tony & another young boy named Cain
 another boy Dick and one girl named Judy another named Mariah
 another girl named Jin another Named yanaca another boy named
 Mare another girl named Lydia allse I give unto my beloved
 wife one Sorrell mare & one brown bay mare & one two year old
 sorrell horse allse all my stock of Cattle & sheep belonging
 to my home plantation allse all my stock of hogs except ten
 breeding sows, alls I give Unto My beloved wife mary Foxworth
 all my household furniture except two feather beds, & furniture
 Item I - I give Unto my beloved son Stephen Foxworth all my
 other Lands, that I am posfessed with and all the Cattle in his
 own Mark allse all my other stock of Cattle Except the home
 stock I give Unto my son Stephen Foxworth one Negree wench named
 hannah & one boy Named allick one ether negree boy named Jeffry
 to him & heirs forever I give unto my son steven Foxworth one
 negree boy and ~~gan~~ Dick and one negree girl Named yanaca and
 one boy named Mare allready given to my beloved wife Mary
 Foxworth but he not to have said negrees till her Death shan to
 be his & his heirs forever May all other of the Negrees all
 other of the household furniture all the stock of Cattle sheep
 & hogs allse Every other species of property but - ~~unenumerated~~

I give unto my beloved Wife to Dispossess of as shee shall think proper I Give unto my son steven foxworth two head of horses one a two year old Last spring the other a year old Last spring to him & his heirs forever my Desire Is that is if my son should Die without Isfhus or marrying My Desire is that the three Negroes James Dick & yamasa and naree should return back to my wife or her heirs Given Under my hand & seal this 15th Day of october 1799 allso I Leave my beloved wife mary Foxworth & my son Stephen Foxworth & John-Graham-Son my Executors to this my last will & testament signed sealed & Delivered in the presence of us -----
