for my Family and whatever surplus there may remain after pay-
ing my Debts I wish it to be appropriated with all good Economy
to the support of my Family and raising my Small Children and
should any Remain after Raising and Schooling my said Children
I will and Desire the same to be Divided betwixt my beloved
