I John Graham of the state and district aforesaid planter being of sound mind memory and understanding thanks be to Almighty God for the same, and calling to mind the mortality of this life, and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, do hereby make and ordain this my last will and Testament in manner and form following to wit. - I recommend my soul unto the Almighty who gave it, and my body to the earth to be buried in a decent Christian like manner, and as touching such worldly Estate as the Lord has blessed me with, I give and dispose of it in following manner. Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Sarah Ward wife of William N. Ward One dollar to be paid to her in Cash by my executors., I also lend unto my Said daughter Sarah Ward five Cows and Calves during her natural life & should she die without lawful issue, the said Cattle to be divided given to my Son John

Item, I give and bequeath to my daughter Rebecca Fleyd wife of Alfred P. Fleyd One dollar in Cash, to be paid to her by my Executors. *

Item, I give and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Cooper wife of Bartly Cooper, One dollar to be paid to her by my Executors. --

Item - I give and bequeath to my daughter Jane Cooper wife of Ezekiel Cooper One hundred dollars to be paid her by my Executors.

Item, I give and bequeath to my Son John Graham all the rest and residue of my Estate that I may be in possession of at my death, after the above bequest are fulfilled and complied with by my executors,
