In the name of God Amen I William Jordan Se^r of Horry Distriet
State of South Carolina planter Being Very Infurm and weeks of
Body but of Perfect mind and memory thanks be to God for the
Same - and Calling to mind the Mortallity of the Body and know-
ing that is ordained for all^{man} kind once to Die Thairfore
think it preper to ordain and Constitute this my Last will and
testament in the fellow manner - First and principally I
Recommend my Soul to God that Gave it my Body to be Buried at
the Discretion of my Executors hereafter Mentioned and as Touch-
ing such worldly property as it hath pleased God to Bleis me
with I Give in the following manner -----

Inprimis I Give to my Beloved wife Mary Jordan the use of my
plantation I now Live on with all my House hold & Kitchen Furni-
ture and one Sattel Mare Branded W & and Negroe Woman Dinah (but
not her increase) During her Life and at her Death the whole to
be Divided between My Surviveing Children to Gather with that
part of the Cattle Cal,d here

I Give unto my Son Adem Jordan one Shilling to be paid on
Demised

I Give unto my Son William Jordan all my Coopers tools -----

I Give unto my son James Jordan one negro boy Moses but he must
Pay the hairs to make them all Equal in the Value of his Shares
& thairs With one Cow and Calf -----

I Give unto my Son Jehn Jordan one young Bay horse Branded W &
with all my Sheemakers tools, and -----

and at the time of My Wifes Decace I Give the whole of the Tract
of Land I now Live on to be Equally Divided Between My Sons
Christoper & Solomon Jordans to them and thair hairs and if a
the Remainder of my Estate both Real and personal to be Equally
Divided between my hairs when my youngest Child Comes of Lawfull
age and till that time to be kept together by My Executors ----
And Should any of My Children Die Miners thair Parts to be
Divided amongst the Survivors -----

Lastly I do Nominate and apoint My Beloved Wife Mary Jordan
