Jacob Niars - first Master in George Town - ~~is to be sold at two Years Credit - with~~

Sharlotter --- have five dollars a year. during her widowhood --- and If ther Should be a Remainder of Many I desire it to be Equally divided among the ears of Elisha Tillman - his Eldest daughter Excepted -- this My last will and testement.
