my Negro Wench Betty - now in care of H. Jacob Miers - first

Master in George Town - As to be Sold at two Years Credit - with  
Bond and Interest - and sufficient Security -- the Money then  
to be collected and appropriated to the Use of purchasing young  
Negro girls of which I gave and bequeath to all the Mrs of  
Elisha and An Tillman his wife - Except Mary Ann Tillman -- to  
be Equally divided - I further desire that all My out Standing  
debts Should be Collected - and all My other property - Such as  
household furniture - horses - Cattle - hogs and all property  
that may be proved to Mine to be Sold at publick Sale --- and  
after the Sale I gave and Bequeath to My two cousins --- Mary  
Ann Covar -- and Elizabeth Covar --- three hundred dollars to  
be Equally divided -- and I further divide - that My dear Be-
