

# WILL OF

DANIEL H. LEWIS

South. Carolina

In the Name of God Amen, I Daniel Harry Lewis of Allsaints Parish and State aforesaid, being weak in body but of a sound Mind and Memory Blessed be God for the same; do make and Ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following Vis: I recommend my Soul to God who gave it, and my Body to be buried in a decent Christian Manner, by my Executors hereafter Named -

Item, I give and bequeath to my Dear beloved Wife Mary Lewis One Negro Girl Named Lenah with all her future Issue all my Household and Kitchen furniture, (Except what is hereafter Mentioned) all my Stock of Cattle, My Horse, and all my Crop, These to be in lns. and bar of her Dower, of my Land

Item I give and bequeath to my Child my Wife is now pregnant with Five Negroes Namely Cyrus, Florah, Cate, Ben and Alsey, One Feather Bed and furniture, Two Trunks and One Chest, and my Shot Gun, but if my said Child should die before it arrives to Twelve Years of Age, Then I give unto my Wife Two of the said Negroes Vis Cate and Ben, with there future Issue and the Two Trunks and Chest for ever, Item I give to my Niece Rachel Lewis (should my Child die as aBove Stated) One Negro Girl Named Alsey, One Feather Bed and furniture for ever Item I also give to my Nephew Ebenezer Lewis (if my child dies as aBove) Two Negroes Vis Cyrus and Florah and my Shot Gun for ever - Item I give to my Brother Charles Lewis my Cast net; My Land and Mill Stones, it is my will that they shall be sold, to pay all my Just debts, and should their be any left after my debts is paid, I give it to my Child above Named - Lastly I nominate and Appoint my Brother Charles Lewis, and John Duettt Sen., Executors, to this my Last will and Testament, In presents whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and Seal, this Twenty third day of December, In the Year One Thousand Eight hundred and Eleven, and Thirty Sixth Year of the Independence of the United States of America
