In the Name of God Amen. I, Thomas Livingston of the State of South Carolina in the District of Horry - being in Sound mind memory and understanding - praised be God for the Same, do make this my last will and testament in manner and form following: First I will and desire that I may be decently buried in the burying Ground on the plantation where I Reside: and I Give and bequeath unto my Daughter Mary Ludlam Four Negrows Named. Ceasar Jacob Florow and Gim hir Child also one feather bed and furniture, also one Small bed and furniture I will and Bequeath to my Grand Daughter Jane Ludlam Also I Give and Bequeath unto my Son Thomas Livingston two Negrows Named July and Cuffey, also the plantation or track of land where I now live also a track of land - Containing one Hundred Acoers Colled Sandy Bluff: also I Give and bequeath unto Margreat Hardee Deceased hir Children Two Negrows Named Esaw and Joe also I Give and bequeath unto my Grand Daughter Elizabeth Hardee one Feather bed and furniture: also I Give and Bequeath unto my Grand Son Thomas Livingston Son of Robert Livingston Deceased one Negrow wench Named Clarrender and hir Child named Maryann also Three Tracks of land lying on Simpson Crick Swamp in the District of Horry one Containing Eight Hundred Acoers another of one hundred, the third of one Hundred and Sixty Acoers: also Give and Bequeath unto my Grand Son Robert Livingston Son of Robert Livingston Deceased one Negrow Named Champain to him and his Heirs forever: also I Give and Bequeath unto my Grand Daughter - Susanna Vereen Daughter of Jane Vereen Deceased one Negrow Carl named Jude: also I Give and Bequeath unto my Grand Son Samuel Porter Vereen Son of Jane Vereen Deceased one Negrow Named Dave: also I Give and Bequeath unto William Todd Son of Mary Deavenport one Negrow Named Tom: also I give and Bequeath unto my Son in law Jeremiah Ludlam one Track of land Containg one Hundred and fifty Acoers lying on Waccamaw River: all the real and Residue of my Estate both real and personal to be Sold by my Exeuter hereinafter named: I do nominate Constitute and appoint Thomas Livingston and William / Sole Executors of this

 Bequeath unto Thomas Livingston Son of Robert Livingston Deceased  
 and a Equal part of the Rest - I also Give and Bequeith unto  
 Thomas Hardee Son of - Margaret Hardee Deceased one Track of  
 land Containing Five Hundred Acres lying on Simpson Creek - I  
 hereby Revoke and make Void all and Every other Will and Wills  
 at any time heretofore by me made and do declair this to be  
 my last will and Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto  
 Set my hand and Seal this 8<sup>h</sup> day of October 1815  
 The Livingston (Seal)
