I Robert Lowmore Senior, of the State & District aforesaid, considering the uncertainty of this Mortal Life, being of a Sound and perfect mind, and memory Blesed be Almighty God, for the Same ----- Do make and publish this as my last will and Testament -- In a manner and form following ( That is to say ) First I give and bequeath Unto my beloved Wife Sarah Lowmore, all my Ready Money, and it is my desire, that She Should be the Whole prepritor of the house and plantation where I now Reside during her Life or Widowhood and at her disposal, as She may think proper to the Use and benefit of my Family. ----- I do also give and bequeath unto my Eldest Son, Robert I Lowmore my Large family Bible, in addition to what I formally have given him ----- I do also give and bequeath Unto my Grand Children the heirs of my Eldest Daughter Mary Miliken - - the Sum of one Dollar each. I do also give and bequeath Unto my Daughter Ann Lowmore all the Cattle in my Steek which have the Mark of a Crop and Two Splits in one ear, and a Crop and half Crop in the other ear, And all the Hogs and their Increase that are now Cald hers, ----- Also one bed, and furniture. I do give and bequeath unto the heirs of my daughter or Elizabeth Paul, deceased in addition to what I formally gave her two Cows and Calves, if there Should be as many as four left after the decease of my Wife, of the Cattle which I and my Wife Claim and Exclusive of what the other Children Claim, I do also give and bequeath unto my Daughter Sarah Parker or her Heirs, in addition to what I formally gave her two Cows and Calves if their Should be as many as four Left after the decease of my Wife of the Cattle which I and my Wife Claim and exclusive of what the other Children Claim, I do also give and bequeath unto my Daughter Anny Lowmore, All the Cattle in my Steek Which have the mark of a Crop and two Splits in one Year, and a Swallow fork in the other Also all the hogs and their Increase, that are now sale hers, Also One bed and furniture, I do also give and bequeath Unto my Daughter Esther Lowmore All the Cattle in my Steek which have the mark of a Crop

in one ear, and a Swallow fork in the other ear.

and also the hogs which are called hogs and one bed and furniture. I do also give and bequeath unto my Youngest Son William James Lowmore All the Cattle in my Stock Which have the Mark of a Crop and Two Splits in one ear, and a Crop and one Split in the other and all the hogs that are called his The Mark is to be his after the death of his Mother also one bed and furniture, Likewise a Tract of one hundred and fifty - Acres of Land Where I now Reside and the mills thereon with the Exception of the house. I now live in and Three Acres around it, While my three (Daughters Ann Anne's and Esther Remain unmarried, and make Choice to Live on Said Lands, if they Should Marry or Leave it then the Exceptions made for them to be void and of no effect, I do also give and bequeath unto my three Daughters now Living with me, and Anne's and Esther one Tract of Land containing Two hundred Acres (being a part of a Tract of Land granted to William Smith) to have and to hold forever, It is my Desire that a debt due me for a Tract of Land I sold to Thomas Sanders When Collected to be equally divided between my four Children Who are now Living with me, Also tis my desire That the plantation and other Tools of What ever name or nature should belong to W I Lowmore at the decease of my beloved Wife, also it is my desire that all the house hold and Kitchen furniture with all these articles not Claimed or mentioned in this Will, I wish at the death of my beloved Wife to be equally divided between my four Children now Living with me, (Vis) Ann Anne's Esther and W.I. Lowmore, and Lastly as to all the Rest Residue and Remainder of my Personal Estate goods and Chattles of What Kind and nature Soever I give and bequeath the Same to my Said beloved Wife Sarah Lowmore to dispose of as she may think proper, Whom I hereby Appoint sole Executrix of this my last Will and Testament be it Remembered that if any of the Within mentioned Children which are unmarried and are now Living with me Should die<sup>d</sup> without Issue it is my will that their property should be equally divided between the Surviving Ones ----- And I in Witne's whereof Set my hand and Seal this 25th day of July In the Year of our Lord One thousand Eight Hundred and Thirty-five and in the Thirtieth Year of the Independence of the United States of America
