following Manner - first I give my Soul to god who gave it me
and My body to be --Buried in a Christian ^{Manner} / at the Discretion
of my Executors hereafter -- Mentioned and as to What worldly
goods it hath pleased god to blifs me With I will and bequeath
in the following Manner. Item I lend unto My - Beloved Wife
Catherine Grainger the plantation and Tract of land on which
I now live During her natural life also all my household and
Kitchen Furniture and plantation Tools.. Item I give unto my
sons Samuel Mathew Thomas and Lewis the plantation and Tract
of land lent to my wife also the plantation tools and household
and Kitchen Furniture also all my land and all my Stock of
Every Kind with Every specis of - property which I am pofessed
with to be Equelly Divided betwixt My four sons Namely Samuel
Mathew Thomas and Lewis my desire is that no division may Take
place untill my yongest arives son Lewis arives to the age of
twenty - one years ~~of age or Marriage~~ or Maries My disire is
that if it should so happen that Either of My four sons above
named Should die before my yongest son arives to the age of
twenty one years or be Maried that his part shall go to the
Surviving sons above named provided Neither of my sons above
Named should have no Issue but should Either of them have a
Child or Children then and in that Case my Desire is that his
part of my Estate Real and personal shall go to said - Child
or Children. Item I give unto My son John Grainger one Shill-
ing - Sterling to be paid him by my Executors Item I give unto
My son furnifeld and My three four Daughters that is Lowe
Goodyear Elisabeth Sineth Mary Watts and Catherine Grainger one
shilling sterling each. I appeint my - Two sons Mathew and
Samuel Grainger Executors to this my last will and Testament
