Item I give unto my sons Samuel Mathew Thomas and Lewis the plantation and Tract of land lent to my wife also the plantation toels and housheld and Kitchen Furniture also all my land and all my Stock of Every Kind with Every specie of - property which I am pofsesed with to be Equelly Divided betwirt My four sons damely Samuel Mathew Thomas and Lewis my desire is that no division may Take place untill my yengest asives sen Lewis arives to the age of twenty - one years of-ago-or-Massinge or Maries My distre is that if it should so happen that Either of My four sons above paned Should die before my yongest son arives to the age of twenty one years or be Maried that his part shall go to the Surviving sons above named provided Beither of my sons above Numed should have no Isue but should Either of them have a Child or Children then and in that Case my Desire is that his part of my Batate Real and personal shall go to said - Child er Children. Item I give unto My son John Grainger one Shilling - Sterling to be paid him by my Executors Item I give unto My son furnifeld and My three four Daughters that is Lewe Goodyear Elizabeth Sineth Mary Watte and Catherine Grainger ene shilling sterling Each. I appoint my - Two sons Mathew and Samuel Grainger Resouters to this my last will and Testament
