C. Powel one Cow and Olalf Item I give to my Sister Mary Powel all my land and plantation with my tools and half my hogs and all my Corn and meat with all the rest in my House Item I give to my Brother Thomas Fips my oxen and the other half of my Hogs and Rifle gun lastly I do make and Constitute and make my Brethrin law Felix Powel and his wife Executors of this my last will and testament dated this 13<sup>th</sup> of February in the year of our Lord 1613
