my land and plantation with my tools and half my hogs and all  
my Corn and meat with all the rest in my House Item I give to  
my Brother Thomas Pips my oxen and the other half of my Hogs  
and Rifle gun lastly I do make and Constitute and make my  
Brother in law Felix Powel and his wife Executors of this my  
last will and testament dated this 13<sup>th</sup> of February in the year  
of our Lord 1813
