Camden it is my Desire that Tho. Porter Should carry them
on by the Assistance of my Aternies the Same as if I was
Liveing untill they are Settled according to Law and then
it is my Desire that the money or property which may be
Recovered by Said Suits / ^{if any} now in Law may be put or Left in
the hands of Said Thomas Porter to pay all my Just Debts
in the First place and the Ballance ~~to be~~ to be Dispos
of in the Following Clause

I Give and bequeath to my Son William Evens one Shot Gun
which I Rate at ten Dollars and Nothing more and the Bal-
lance of my Estate if any After my Death after the Said
Tho. Porter Who I Leave to do all my business is paid for
his trouble to be Equally Devided betwixt my three Grand
children peggy Bullard Susan Evens and Ransom Evens
And I do here by utterly Disallow Revoke and Disannul all
and Every other former testaments wills Legacies bequests
and Executors Ratifying and Confirming this and no ther to
be my Last will and testament in witnefs Whereof I have
Hare unto Set my hand and Seal this twentieth day of June
in the yeare of our Lord one thousand Eight Hundre & twenty
one
