Item, I give & Bequeath to my loving Wife Alice the one half of my Personal Estate only yielding to my Son William my Young roan mare & foal and the one half of my Cattle, and as touching my Real Estate I leave to my Son William all the land above the Branch only his Mother to live on it during her pleasure, Also I give and bequeath unto my Son Charles all the Land that is below the Branch. I desire that my Debts which I owe to any body be truly paid by my Executors hereafter named, I also appoint Joseph Kershaw & Archibald Watson my Sole Executors of this my last Will & Testament In Witness whereof I have set my hand & seal this 27th day of January 1781 Sealed and delivered in the presence of
