

## WILL OF

JOHN WILLIAMS

In the Name of God I John Williams of Saint Marks parish and  
Province of South Carolina planter being sound and disposing  
mind & memory do make & Ordain this my last will & Testament  
in Wanner & form following Viz: I commit my soul to the mercy  
of Almighty God trusting in the merits of my blessed Redeemer  
my body to be entered at the discretion of my Executrix herein  
after Named I will that all my debts & funeral charges be paid  
& discharged by my said said Executrix to discharge said debts,  
I will the following Negroes to be sold viz: Jim. Anis. Claris.  
Sal. J Eyr, also I give & bequeath unto my two sons Rowland  
John, and William all Tract or Tracts plantation or parcels of  
Land that I now reside on situate on the high hills of Santee  
to be equally divided between them as soon as the Eldest son  
Rowan John arrives at the age of Twenty one years with appur-  
tenances thereto belonging to my said sons Rowland John &  
William their heirs & assigns forever to be divided as above  
Mentioned. Reserving the third part of the above said Tract  
Plantation or Parcel of Land to my Loving Wife during her  
natural life also I land unto my said loving wife during her  
said lifetime the following Slaves Viz George Winney & Isaac  
& her decease to be divided amongst all my Children Viz: sons  
Rowland John & William, Daughters Betsey, Polly, Anne Sally &  
Peggy, Also I will that my Youngest son William be bound to a  
trade becoming his disposition and my eldest son Rowland John  
be at his Mothers direction during her Widhood but in case  
of her marrying to be put to a trade according to his Constit-  
ution & disposition also I will a bequeath Whatever is re-  
covered by a suit now depending or perhaps determined in  
Chancery in the Province of North Carolina may be equally di-  
vided among my said Children allowing my said wife a Childs

part or portion of the same to be laid out in purchasing slaves  
& putting the said said slaves into the Gen. Stock for the use  
& benefit of my Children as above Mentioned also I will that  
all my Estate both real & personal, & every part thereof when a  
Division is required as herein directed be equally divided a-  
mongst my said Children at the Discretion of two or three  
reputable honest Neighbors my two sons above Named to have their  
part at the age of Twenty one years my S. Daughters above Named  
to have their part or portion as each of them Marrieth that is  
every one to have her portion or part according to the term of  
her Marriage or if unmarried at the age of twenty one years a  
also I will that my said wife ~~will~~ <sup>shall</sup> improve the said  
Estate during her widowhood within Divided & Considered as above  
Directed for the use & benefit of all & ever one of my S.  
Children but in case of my said Wife's Marriage then my said  
Estate to be divided as above willed & directed. Lastly I do  
will & Constitute my S. Wife Mary Williams Executrix of this  
my last will & Testament. In Witness whereof I hereunto fix  
my hand & seal date this eighteenth day of January in the year  
of Our Lord One Thousand seven hundred & Seven-<sup>5</sup>Five.
