In the Name of god amen I Jonathan Bunckley of the State and County aforesaid being thro the abundant Mercy of god the Weake in body yet of a sound and perfect understanding and memory Doe Constitute this my last will and testament and Desire it may be Received by all as Such first I most humbly bequeath my Soul to god my Maker beseeching his most gracious acceptance of it throug the all Suffician ments and mideation of my most Compasinate Redeemer Jesus Christ who gave himself to be an atonement for my Sins and is able to Save to the utmost all that Come unto god by him Seeing he Ever Liveeth to make intercession for them and Who I trust Will not Reject me being penitant Sinner when I Come to him for mercy in this hope and Confidence I Render up my Soul with Comfort humbly beseeching the most blessed and gloriou trinity one god most holy most mercifell and gracious to pr-pare me for the time of my Disalution and then to take me to himself into that peace and rest and incomparable filicity which he has prepared for all that Love and fear his holy name amen blessed be god I give my body to the Earth from whence it Was taken in full asurance of its Resurrection from thence at the Last day--- as to Wourldly Estate I will and positively order that all my Debts be paid # item 1 I Will that all my Worldly Estate both Real and Personal be Lent to my Wife Maris Except as heare after Excepted that is to Say item 2 I will that all my Children Except Riskey Payne and Elizabeth Dunn who have already had about five pounds from me--that the Rest Namely John Bunckley Amy Bunckley Mary David Robert Bunckley Burrell Bunckley Jonathan Bunckley and Catherine Bunckley receive out of my estate the sum of five pounds each to be paid them as they Come to age or demand it item 3 I will

that at the Death of my wife the Whole of my property both Real and personal be Equally Divided between the Whole of my Children as well Riskey paine and Elisabeth Dunn as those above mentioned but the Whole to be Lent to my wife During her Natural Life Except as above Excepted and then to Divide by Sail or agreement which Shall Seem most agreeable to my Executors Lastly I Doo Constitute and appoint my too friends Lewis Collins and Jacob Chambers Executors of this my Last will and testament and trustees for my wife and Children in witness where of I have hereunto Set my hand and Seal this 13th day of October in the Year of our Lord 1799.
