

WILL OF
WILLIAM CLEMONS.

In the name of God amen I William Clemons of Camden district planter in the State of SeCarolina, This 30th. day of June 1784 being of sound and disposing mind & memory do make and ordain this my last will & testament in manner & form following, first that my funeral charges and all my lawful & Just debts be paid.

Item I give & bequeath unto my son Michael that plantation or Tract of Land cont.g. 100 Acres which I now dwell on, nevertheless my dear and well beloved wife is to have the privilege of living upon ^d said land during her natural life.

Item, I do positively order that when my son Michael arrives to the age of Twenty one years That my two negroes named be equally divided between my wife and all my children each to have an equal share, provided nevertheless if my said wife be then alive, she is to have one negro during her natural life, and after her death to be divided equally among all my children----

Item My wish and desire is that my daughter Martha's proportionable part of the above mentioned Negroes, and the cattle she has already rec- ^d be to her and her Issue for ever, Item my wish & desire is that the whole profits made of my estate after my death be equally divided between my wife and Seven children viz-- Kathrine, Sarah, William, James, Christian, David & Michael, and if any of my said Seven children die before of age their part to equally divided among the Surviving children.

And lastly all the rem^d of my estate shall be equally divided into Seven equal shares, between my said Seven children viz.--Kathrine, Sarah, William, James, Christian David & Michael, when my said son Michael is twenty one years of age, he now being in the Seventh yr- of his age--- And further that my children be schooled of the whole profits--

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And I do hereby authorize, constitute nominate and app^t. my
dear Wife Martha Ext^{rx}, Arthur Clemons and W^m Clemons my
two fons Executors of this my last will & testament, and do
hereby disannul every former will & testament & do declare t
this my last will & Testament in the presence of
Witnesses
