ow by marriage it is my Desire and will that she gets one bed and
furniture and one horse and saddle and such or Executors May
think Right and Equal and it is my Desire that when my wife ceases
to be my Widow Either by Death or Marriage that the Land to my
four sons that is George William turned Thomas; and I do leave it
solely with my Executors to Devide it Equally among them as they
think Right and its my further Will and Desire that if any of
those Children die before they are of age there part to be Equally
lly Devided between the others that is there full Brothers and
Sisters and when the Land is devided and said off to my above
Named sons it is my will that they pay there four Sisters that is
Ginna Betsey Neemiah and Salley one hundred Dollars Each and do
give all the above Named property to the persons it is given to
them and there Heirs for ever and it is my further Will & I do
give to my Son John one hundred acres of Land whereon he now lives

in three months after my Decease I also give my son Robert one hundred acres of land where he Now Lives to be paid of up and down the Branch I do give the same to him and his heirs forever Upon his paying My Daughter Catharine one hundred Dollars in three Months after my Decease and I also give to my son James one hundred and thirty five acres of Land Whereon he Now lives and I do give the same to him and his heirs forever provided he pays my Daughter Elley one hundred Dollars in three Months after my Decease I do also give my son George one sorrel Filley known by the Name of Pigion also one saddle and Bridle and I do give the same to him and his heirs forever and it is my further will and Desire that the decease of my wife that all the rest of my Estate of what Nature or quality it may be not Before Disposed off may be sold and the proceeds equally divided among my Eight youngest Children and I do give the same to them and there heirs forever and lastly I do constitute and appoint my tusty Friends James McKahan and Joseph Hollingsworth Executors of this my Last Will
