Item 1st I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Rutha Breascale my house and plantation whereon I now live containing 600 acres with the whole of my personal Estate not otherwise hereafter disposed of-----

Item 2nd I have given unto my beloved daughter Hamtal Hall the three following negroes Mida which has deed since given by me Harriet and Dorisida two feather Beds and furniture one Horse beidle and saddle and two Cows & calves

Item 3rd I do also now give and bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Buldal Johnson the three following negroes (VIZ) Zealous Lensey

and Stephen also two feather Beds and furniture one horse saddle and beidle and two Cows & calves-----

and Stephen also two feather Beds and furniture one horse saddle and bridle and two Cows & calves-----

Item 4th I do also give and bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Caroline Breascale three negroes named as follows Dennis Eliza and Cornelia also two feather Beds and furniture one horse saddle and bridle and two cows and calves when she marries or becomes of age

Item 5th It is my will and desire that the remaining part of my real Estate being in Edgefield & Abbeville Dist be sold for an equal division between my three children.-----

Item 6th It is my will and desire that after the death of my beloved wife Rutha Breascale that my Land whereon I now live be divided by appraisement or sale between my Daughter Hannah & Carolin and that my personal Estate be sold or appraised so that my daughter Hannah Hillshall be made equal with my other two Daughters that is to say have so much property in money or negroes as would be her distributive share in the land which I will to my two Daughters with the exception of Two Hundred Dollars which she

hereby nominate constitute and appoint my two sons in Law Wiley
Hill & George W Johnson Executors to my last will and testament
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the 10th
Day of April in the ye r of our Lord one Thousand eight hundred
and Twenty Six and of American Independence the fiftieth
