Second I give To my Daughter Salley Garretto one Gray Horse about fifteen hands & a half high Seven years old to be delivered at my Death and one Large Bible.

Thirdly I give to my Daughter Policy Mathews one bay mare about fifteen hands high Six or Seven years old and one side Saddle &

fifteen hands & a half High four years old to be kept at her
Death and one large bibie.

fifteen hands high Six or Seven years old and one side Saddle &

Fourthly all the余tions of my personal estate after my Just debts
are paid I give to my wife Hetty Mathews During her Natural life
and at her Death to Decend to my Daughter Polly Mathews

Garrett Jun.^r Executors to this my last will and testament
