Second I give To my Daughter Salley Garrette one Gray Horse about fifteen hands & a half high Seven years old to be Delivered at my Death and one large bible.

Thirdley I give to my Daughter Polley Mathews one bay mare about fifteen hands high Six or Seven years old and one side Saddle & Bridle on bed bedsted & furniture—

Second I give To my Daughter Salley Garrette one Gray Horse about
fifteen hands & a half high seven years old to be delivered at my
Death and one large bible.

Thirdly I give to my Daughter Policy Mathews one bay mare about
fifteen hands high Six or Seven years old and one side Saddle &
Bridle on bed bedsted & furniture-

Fourthly all the residue of my personal estate after my Just Debts
are paid I give to my wife Hetty Mathews During her Naturl life
and at her De th to Decend to my Daughter Pollyolly Mathews-----

Lastly I do make constitute and appoint Hetty Mathews and Jesse
Garrett Jun.^r Executors to this my last will and testament
