

Laurens-District----- / I John McCurley of the said State and
District aforesaid Planter being in a low State of Health But of
Sound and Disposing Mind and Memory thanks be to God for the
same and knowing that it is appointed for all Men once to die
do make this my Last will and testament revoking all others by me
heretofore made acknowledging this and no other as my Last will--
First I give and bequeath to my Wife Pelly McCurley a Life Estate
in all my Lands good & Chattel after paying all my Just debts
and if what is owing to me is not sufficient to pay all my debts
then she is to sell as much of my stock as will make up the
deficiency

Secondly-And at the death of my wife then I give and bequeath
to my son George McCurley all of my Lands to him his heirs and
assigns for ever-----

Thirdly-to my two Daughters Nancy Davis & Peggy Shirley as I have
already given to each of them one Bed & furniture it is as much
as I can give to each of my children therefore it is all that I
intend for them at present-----

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Fourthly as I have five single Daughters I do hereby direct my wife
on there becoming of Lawfull age or Marrying to give to each of
them one bed and furniture or the Value thare of in Money or
other property as they may see-----

Fifthly as my son Inlas Who Married my Daughter Peggy has Buildd
himself a house on my land I do allow him to keep possession of the
same for four years from my death he not to commit any Waste on
said Land-----

Sixthly and at the death of my wife then all the property that is
then remaining not before disposed of by this my will is to be
Sold and equally divided amongst all my Children or there Lawfull
heirs share and share alike-----

Lastly I do hereby appoint my Wife Polly McCurley Executrix and
my son George McCurley Executor of this my last will and testament
Witness my hand this 12th day of March 1822 Signed and acknowledged in the presence
