to law age to received the same and I vaive my son John Jones
one Dollar. the balance of my property to be Sold and pay my

I give to my grand son Leander Duncan my plantation to wit and
the money to be put to intrust untill Leander Duncan Shall come
to law age to received the same and I vaive my son John Jones
one Dollar. the balence of my property to be Sold and pay my
Just Debt funeral expence to be paid and the allance to bee
Equally divided betwin the rest of my children.

And if the said Leander Duncan Should Die with out any heir the
Salle of my land to Equilly Devided betwin John Watson children
and Lastly I do constitue and appoint my Said Son Joseph Jones
and John Watson Executors of this my Last will and testatment
hereby revoking of orth and former wills testemtn by me hereto
fore maid in testamtny whereof I have hereunto Set my hand and
affixed my Seal this 21st day of July 1826 and the fofety first
year of the Independance of the united States of America
Signed Sealed published and Declared as my Last and Testament of
the Above named Josaph Jones in the presence of us
