knowing it is appointed for all once to Die Do make and ordain  
this my Last will and testement that is to say principaley and  
first of all I Give and recomend my soul Into the hand of  
almighty God that Gave It and my Bodey to the earth to be  
buryd In Decent Christian burial at the Discretion of my  
Executors Nothing Doubting but at the General Resurrection I  
shall receive the same again by the mightey power of God, and  
as touching such worldley estate where with it has pleased God  
to blefs me in this Life I Give and Dispose of the same in the  
the following manner and form

First I Give and bequeath to my son John man - John Gara and  
manasa man both Liveing with me at this time all my Goods and  
Chattles to be equaley Divided among them excepting my bodey  
Cloaths ~~and~~ and saddle my Cloaths is to be Divided between my  
sone Johns wife and my son Roberts wife first paying out of  
my my first bequest to my sone James man the sum of five  
shillings and my saddle I Give to Jane man Daughter to my sone  
~~James~~ Robert ----- and I Do hereby utterley Disalow revoke  
and Disenul all and every other testements wills Legacies  
bequests and Executors by me in any wise before named willd  
or bequeathd Ratifying this and no other to be my Last will  
and testement and I Do appoint and ordain basel prator sen.  
my whole sole executor of this my Last <sup>will</sup> and testement For  
witnefs where of I have here unto set my hand and seal this  
21.. Day of augus 1797
