 Laurens District I Mary Cole of the District and State
 aforesaid being old and calling to mind that it is appointed for
 all men to die I do make and ordain this my last will
 and Testament In the first place I commend my soul into
 the hands of Al mighty God to be with me and my body to be
 decently buried at the Discretion of my Executors
 herein after named And as regards such movable Estate with
 which God has blessed me I Dispose of as follows 1st my
 Will is that all my Personal Property Except my negro Slave
 be sold on a Credit of Twelve months and the money arising
 therefrom together with all other monies that may be due
 or owing to me at my Death be applied that is, so much thereof
 as may be necessary to the payment of my Just Debts and fune-
 ral Expenses And the balance of the same I bequeath to my
 Daughter Nancy Pearson for her sole Separate and Exclusive
 use and Benefit over which her husband shall have no
 Control neither shall the same in any way be liable to his
 Contracts or Subject to his Debts During his life and if any should
 Remain at her Death then that the same shall remain to the use
 and Benefit of the child or children of my daughter who may
 be surviving and if there be none then the same shall be liable
 to be disposed of in such way and manner as my daughter
 may deem best Secondly I will bequeath and direct that my
 Executor herein after named do sell at Public auction on a
 Credit of Twelve months the following negro Slaves (Wife)
 Sarah Jane Hester George Joseph Calambi Mary Harriet and Lucinda
 and what her issue and in case the aforesaid females may bear
 at the time of my death and that the proceeds arising from the
 said Sale be equally Divided between my Grand Children
 William Andrews Pally Feltz Allen Andrews Ephraim Andrews
 Nancy Williams Elizabeth Blackburn Edmy Andrews Young Andrews
 the parts and shares bequeathed to my Grand Children as to them to
 their respective use and Benefit and to their child or children
 respectively forever and if any of my aforesaid Grand Children
 should die without issue then at their his or her death
 then his or her share to go to the other Grand Children and the
 part that may go to my Grand Daughter or daughters to remain as above
 stated Thirdly I desire that my Grand Children mentioned in
 the former clause take care of my faithful old Slave Calambi
 During her life and that she shall live with whomsoever of them
 she may choose -

 Lastly I do nominate constitute and appoint my beloved
 by nature son Allen Andrews the sole Executor of this my last will
 and Testament hereby revoking all other and former wills by
 me made in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
 and affixed my seal this the nineteenth day of February
 in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and
 thirty two and in the fifty sixth year of the Sovereignty and
 Independence of the United States of America - Signed Sealed
 published and declared by the Above named Mary Cole to be
 her last will and Testament in the presence of us who have
 hereunto Subscribed our names as witnesses in the presence of the
