Sumner District in the State aforesaid being of sound mind and dis-
-posing mind and memory reflecting on the uncertainty of life and
being desirous of disposing of my estate which it has pleased
God to bless me with to make and ordain this my last will &
Testament. I give and bequeath unto my son Robert Dunlap a tract
of land lying in Newberry District known by the name of Salma
old town which he has since sold and disposed of containing
Two Hundred and Sixty seven acres more or less also a house and lot
in the village of Newberry which was conveyed to me by my said son
Robert which he has also since sold and disposed of also the following
Negroes viz, James Isbell and her child Sally, Minnie & Mild and all their
future increase and also all the stock and other articles on the aforesaid
plantation for and during the term of his natural life and after his death
to his lawfull issue. I give and bequeath unto my grand children
Sarah Dunlap William Dunlap Mary Dunlap Robert Dunlap Richard Dunlap
James Dunlap and Sophia, children of my son John Dunlap an equal
interest in the proceeds of the sale of said Hundred and Sixty seven acres
of land on which my son John was permitted adjoining land at
present owned by Doct John Davis Capt John Davis Gilbert Coffey and other
lands belonging to the estate of Thomas Reader and, which tract of
land I direct my Executor herein after named to advertise and
sell on or about the first of January next on a credit of
one and two years and the net proceeds of the sale to

be equally divided and paid over to my aforesaid grand children
as they severally arrive to age or to their proper appointees & executors
I have hereunto for in the lifetime of my son John give him the following
property viz, Joshua Loyden Schriek Mary and her two children and
all their increase and when in merchandise in cash the sum of Ten
= two Hundred and twenty one dollars besides other personal property
deem me as an equal distribution interest which they will receive on
a division of his estate. I give and bequeath unto William & Simpson
Henry & Young & Henry W. Darlington in trust for the sole separate use and
Benefit of my daughter Nancy and the lawfull issue of her body the follo-
= ing property viz, all that plantation or tract of land containing seven
hundred and fifty acres more or less lying on Little River adjoining land
of John O'Keefe the heirs of Robert Pasley Samuel Rodger Nancy Jones and on
Little River and the following Negroes viz, William Jack Sally Parmelia
Patsy Margarett Caroline Middy and her two children Obe and Gabriel and
all their future increase and also one horse one mule fourteen head of cattle fifteen
or twenty head of hogs House hold and kitchen furniture now at the
place a carding machine and wheels and one pig & Harrow as well
Every thing else on the aforesaid plantation not particularly
Enumerated - It is my will and desire that all the aforesaid
property be and remain in the uninterrupted possession of my
said daughter Nancy also one fourth part of the remaining
house hold furniture which I & my wife may in possession of
and should my said daughter Nancy die leaving no lawfull
issue of her body it is my will and desire that the aforesaid property
both Real and personal revert back to my estate. I give and bequeath
unto my friends Doct John W. Simpson Henry & Young & Henry
W. Darlington in trust for the sole separate use and benefit of my
daughter Margarett Dunlap and the lawfull issue of her body
all that plantation or tract of land containing seven
Hundred and twenty eight acres more or less adjoining land of
William Brown Henry Bill John Bryson Thomas Bryson John
Garry Newman Harry Samuel Garry & John Godfrey & Peter Rice
and ten Negroes subject to the life Estate of my wife Margarett
Dunlap & in the event of my daughters Marriage in the
life time of my wife then it is my will and desire that the
aforesaid ten Negroes be named and set a part in families as near
as possible for my said daughter Margarett with the consent and
approbation of my wife and Executors herein after named as well
as all such stock household & kitchen furniture my Gold watch
Chain and safety chain and on the death of my wife it is further my
will and pleasure all the remaining house hold & kitchen
furniture unto the exception of one fourth part already disposed
of to Nancy to be and remain in trust aforesaid

for the separate use and benefit of my said daughter Margaret
but so long as my daughter lives single in the life time of my
wife it is my will and pleasure that the whole of the property
herein bequeathed for her benefit be and remain in common
with that bequeathed to my wife for their joint use and benefit
But should my daughter marry in the life time of my wife
as before stated it is further my will and desire that my
Executors herein after named build or cause to be built on
the aforesaid plantation a good comfortable dwelling house &
other buildings at a cost not exceeding two thousand dollars
to be advanced out of my Estate not otherwise appropriated
Should my said daughter die leaving no lawfull issue then
the whole of the property hereby bequeathed to revert back to my
Estate - I Give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Margaret
I unveil all that plantation or Tract of land in which
I now reside supposed to contain fifteen hundred acres more
or less including the Tract of land purchased of Robert Abel
& the Estate of George Wolf which last Tract I have leased to Mr
Sarah Simpson during her life adjoining lands of John Godfrey
Newman Harry Myatt Shumler Abner Tenger Eliza Leagus
the heirs of John Black Samuel Copeland & Bush River
Also the following negroes viz. Mose Joe Dick Lew Spall Lewis
Henry John Paris Bob Andos Sam Hannah Polly Hitty Abby
Shir Son Clem Andrew Henderson Sons of Hitty Lucy Sher Childs
Tabby, Nancy, Will, Seiley, Mary, Addis, Jerry as well as others
I may be possessed of Should any of my negroes be sold
his or her claim and refractory and become unpleasant to keep
I authorize and direct my Executors and Executrix to sell
and dispose of them or make exchange of them as in their judgment
best comports with the wishes & interest of the family - and further
I Give and bequeath unto my said wife all the Rest Resi-
-dual and Remainder of my Estate both Real and personal
on further Reflection Should my daughter Margaret reside with
my wife until her death in that Event I leave it to the discretion
of my daughter either to take the homestead plantation or the plan-
tation with the Contemplation improve ments thereon and after
taking choice of the two places it is my will and desire that the
same be and remain in the Trust aforesaid for the use and Ben-
-efit of my daughter I further Give and bequeath unto my
beloved wife all that distributive share or interest which be
-hind under & by Virtue of the last will and Testament of
her mother Mrs Sarah Simpson to be disposed of by her
by will or other wise as she may think proper

It is my will and pleasure that all the property here-
-in bequeathed unto my wife be and remain in her possession
during her natural life with the exception of that portion willed
to my daughter Margaret and at her death to be sold and the
money arising therefrom be equally divided among all my children
them & them alike the lawful children to represent the interest of
their deceased parents and that portion which may be coming to
such child whose interest is secured in Trust I hereby direct
my Executors to pay the same over to their Trustees and in the
Event of my wife marrying it is my will and pleasure
that one third of the aforesaid property be set apart for her
during her life and at her death to be sold and divided as
aforesaid - I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint
my beloved wife Margaret Dunlap my friends John
Wartington Esq John W Simpson Esq George Young & Henry
W Warlington Executors & Executrix of this my last will and
Testament hereby Revoking & making null & void all
former wills made by me Ratifying and confirming the
foregoing to my last will & Testament - In witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this
fourteenth day of March in the year of our Lord one
thousand eight hundred and thirty six
