Found in the Office of the Judge of Probate for Laurens County, Laurens, S. C., in the file of the Rev. Aaron and Elizabeth Pinson (Box 56, Packet 3) in July 1979 by Willie Alma White, these papers supplement those published in The Pinson Quarterly, Vol. I, No. 1 (April 1978), pages 49-54 and 56-62.

Approximately 8 inches wide and 6 inches long, folded into vertical thirds with the right-hand third having become separate along the fold, this Appointment of Appraisers chronologically follows the Legatees' Petition dated 3 September 1803, a copy of which appears on pp. 56-57 of the cited Quarterly:

Approximately 7½ inches wide and 6½ inches long, folded into vertical thirds, this Certification of Appraisers chronologically follows the immediately foregoing Appointment of Appraisers:

Approximately 7½ inches wide with a straight top edge but torn off diagonally across the bottom from 5½ inches at the left to 6½ inches at the right, and folded into vertical thirds, this Executor's Petition chronologically follows the Bill of Appraisement dated 27 October 1803, a copy of which appears on page 57 of the cited Quarterly:

to David Anderson ordinary of Laurens District-----
 whereas Aron pinson Decd Made a will and in Said will allowed his wife to Dispose of his property at her death but She diing in testate and Made no Disposhel thareof and I the Said Moses pinson Being Left Excutor of the Said Decd Aron pinson and have taken out Letters Testamintrall - and as in Said will thare is property wich is not Disposed of - and I youre Petitioner prays that you would take My Case into Considerati as thare is a Number of Leagatees and Most of age and Reques thare Partionable of Said Estate and grant Me a order of Saile on a Credit of foreteen Mounths from the Said Sale at or Neere the plantation of the Said Decd this 2th day of Novembr 1803-----

Approximately 7½ inches wide and 12½ inches long, this List of Cash Debts is undated, but chronologically, it should precede the Estate Sale, and may represent sales made by Elizabeth that are mentioned in the Legatees' Petition. Certainly it would have been a part of the Executor's Account dated 11 October 1803 to 11 October 1804, a copy of which appears later herein.

Approximately 7½ inches wide and 4½ inches long, this Memorandum of Sales was probably part of the Executor's Account beginning 11 October 1803 and ending 11 October 1804, a copy of which appears hereinafter:

Approximately 16½ inches wide and 10 inches long, folded in half vertically, then into thirds horizontally, this Executor's Account for 11 October 1803 to 11 October 1804 chronologically precedes the one which appears on pages 60-61 of the cited Quarterly:
